ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above orders were issued for the constitution of Municipal level / District level / State level co-ordination committees to take up monitoring of the implementation of the various activities under INDIRAMMA Programme.

2. In the G.O. second read above, orders were issued for identification of Wards and other preparatory works in the Municipal Corporations and Municipalities for implementation of Phase-II of the INDIRAMMA programme for 2007-08.

3. In the G.O. third read above, orders were issued for the constitution of **Implementation-cum-Monitoring Committees** in Urban Local Bodies as there are no such Committees in the Urban Local Bodies.

4. The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad in his letter 5th read above has stated that, in Hyderabad city, the entire activity pertaining to the sanction and disbursement of social security pensions scheme is being done by the Collector, Hyderabad. The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad has therefore felt that, the involvement of Tahsildars or his representative in the implementation-cum-monitoring Committee for each division especially for the work related to the sanction of new pensions is required. He has therefore requested to issue modified orders for constituting the **Implementation-cum-Monitoring Committees** in respect of Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad accordingly.

5. In the minutes of the meeting on implementation of INDIRAMMA Programme for the year 2007-08 held on 7th March, 2007, it has been decided that the District Collector, Hyderabad will be the Nodal Agency for identification and distribution of pensions in Hyderabad district and District Collectors of Ranga Reddy and Medak will follow saturation approach in 12 municipalities surrounding Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad.

6. Since the District Collector, Hyderabad is the **Nodal Agency** as stated in para 5 above, Government after careful consideration, hereby issue modified orders for constitution of the **Implementation-cum-Monitoring Committees** at Division level in respect of Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad as detailed below:

7. Wherever Corporators are not there, the District Collector, Hyderabad will nominate one person as Chairperson of the Committee after obtaining the approval of the District In-charge Minister.

8. The names of the members of the group will be submitted by the Secretary in consultation with the Chairperson to the District Collector, Hyderabad. The District Collector, Hyderabad will take the approval of the In-charge Minister and constitute the Implementation-cum-Monitoring Committee at the Division level.

9. The **Implementation-cum-Monitoring Committee** will discharge the following functions:

1. To take up awareness campaigns regarding the programme on the continuous basis.
2. To monitor the implementation of the various activities sanctioned under the programme.
3. To ensure that only eligible persons get the benefit under the programme.
4. To report to the Collector, Hyderabad and the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad about eligible beneficiaries, if any left out and the ineligible beneficiaries if any sanctioned any benefit under the programme.
5. The Collector, Hyderabad will consolidate the list of eligible beneficiaries and will place it before District In-charge Minister for final approval.

10. The District Collector, Hyderabad and the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad are requested to organize necessary orientation programme to the members of these committees by utilizing the services of trained District Resource Persons.

11. The District Collector, Hyderabad and the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad are requested to take necessary steps to constitute these committees, immediately.

12. The Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration, A.P., Hyderabad and the District Collectors, Ranga Reddy and Medak districts are directed to follow saturation approach as stated in the reference 4th read above following the instructions already issued in the reference 3rd read above.
