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**ORDER:**

State Government have announced a programme called  
Integrated Novel Development in Rural Areas and Model Municipal  
Areas (INDIRAMMA) to develop all the wards in the Municipal  
Areas over a period of three years by saturating them with  
identified basic infrastructure facilities and welfare measures in a  
focused and time bound manner.

2. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above certain guidelines were  
issued for the implementation of Phase-I of the INDIRAMMA  
Programme for the year 2006-2007.

3. In the references 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Government have  
notified the wards in the Municipal Corporations and Municipal  
Areas under phase-I of the INDIRAMMA Programme for the year  
2006-07 and all the District Collectors and Municipal  
Commissioners were requested to take action for implementing  
the INDIRAMMA scheme in the notified wards.

4. Now, the Government have decided to launch Phase-II of  
the INDIRAMMA Programme during the year 2007-2008. As first  
step towards launch of phase-II of the programme, the Wards will  
be selected. Earlier policy of selecting Wards covering one-third  
population in Municipality will continue to be followed for selection  
of Wards under phase-II. It implies that, Wards covering half of  
the remaining population in a Municipality will be selected. The  
process of selection of Wards will start from 01.02.2007. Under  
developed wards may be given preference. The identification of  
the Wards will be completed under the guidance of the District  
Incharge Ministers. The final list of selected Wards after taking  
approval of the District Level

Coordination Committee and District Incharge Ministers will be sent by the concerned District Collector to the State Government. The process of identification of Wards and its approval by the District Incharge Ministers should be completed by **08-02-2007**.

5. Constitution of **Ward Level Teams** as per the provisions of item 4(i) of G.O.Ms.No. 975, MA & UD (Coordn) Department, dated: 12.12.05 shall also be completed by **08.02.2007**.

6. Necessary orientation programme for the Ward Level Teams regarding objectives of the programme and process to be followed for identification of gaps in respect of the identified activities should be taken up at the District/Municipality level through the District Resource Persons who have been trained already. The orientation programme should be completed by 15.02.2007.

7. Selection of beneficiaries for the individual benefit schemes like Pensions, Housing, ILCS etc., should be started from **16.02.2007**. Ward Level Teams of the concerned Municipal Corporation / Municipalities shall be primarily responsible for the selection of beneficiaries. Officials of the concerned departments should assist the Ward Level Teams in this exercise. The Municipal Commissioner concerned will be responsible for taking up of this exercise. After the list of beneficiaries is compiled, it should be placed before the concerned Municipal Ward Sabha for authentication. Ward Sabha should be conducted in the presence of the public representatives and the concerned Departmental officials should also be present in the Ward Sabha. To ensure this, the dates of the meeting of the Ward Sabha may be decided well in advance and circulated to all the public representatives. This process shall be completed by **15.03.2007**.

8. After the authentication of the list of beneficiaries by the concerned Ward Sabha, seven days time will be given for filing of objections. Any representation / Petition in this regard will be enquired into by the concerned Municipal Commissioner within seven days. The process of filing of objections and completion of enquiry should be completed by **31.03.07**. The final list of identified beneficiaries should be placed before the District Level Coordination Committees for their recommendations.

9. The list of beneficiaries along with the recommendations of the District Level Coordination Committees shall be approved by the District In charge Minister before sending it to the Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration and Municipal Administration and Urban Development Department in the State Government during the first week of April, 2007.

10 Besides the identification of the list of beneficiaries, the assessment of gap in respect of other identified infrastructure community works duly approved by District Level Coordination Committee will also be finalized by **15.04.2007**.

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11. **"Third party agency"** would start the verification of the list of beneficiaries submitted by the District Level Coordination Committee and submit its report to the State Government by **20.04.2007**. Taking into account the findings of the third party agency, the State Level Committee will consider sanction of benefits to the final list of beneficiaries.

12. The Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration and All the District Collectors are requested to take necessary action accordingly in the matter.
