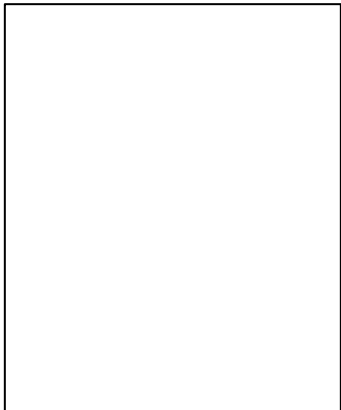

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. All the entries in the application form except Regd. No. should be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.
2. No application form sent by the candidate directly will be entertained in this office i.e. The application forms in respect of ex students duly checked should be forwarded by the forwarding authorities i.e. Principal of the colleges where the candidates last studied, not later than the prescribed date. They will not be permitted to choose any other colleges as centre. Information regarding dates of payment of fee with or without penalty can be had from the Principal of the nearest college presenting candidate for Intermediate Public Examination Candidates who obtained exemption to appear for 1st Year Intermediate Public Examination for the first time as private candidates without college study should not their examination application forwarded to the Board through the Principal of a recognised college where the subjects in which he/she is appearing are taught, and if when he/she proposes to write the examination.

No application will be received by the forwarding authority after the expiry of the last date prescribed event though the fees is paid in time.

3. The entries under Nos.2 to 6 in the application should exactly correspond with those recorded in the certificate issued at the qualifying examination such as SSLC, SSC, Matriculation etc.,
4. Applications with incomplete and incorrect entries are liable to be rejected.
5. Candidates should make their own arrangements with Post Master concerned for re-direction of letters, consequent to any change in their address.
6. In submitting an application for registration to be Public examination, the candidate will be deemed to have given an undertaking that he/she will abide by all Rules in force.
7. Candidates who have already appeared for the examination and are now re-appearing are not permitted to change the languages/subjects under part-II and III or the medium for answering the subjects under Part-II.
8. Candidates should pay the fees in cash to the Principal of a recognised Junior/Degree College offering intermediate course within the dates prescribed.
9. Examination fees/Whole examination :

Candidates applying for the first time should pay the fees in full and offer for the whole examination. Fee once paid will in no circumstances be returned or held over for subsequent examination.

10. The Board of Intermediate Education reserves the right to cancel the admission or the performance of the candidate at any stage when it is detected that his/her admission to the college or the exam is against rules.
11. A private candidate will be allotted the centre through which he/she got his/her application forwarded. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to make sure that the college chosen as a centre imparts instruction in the combinations, papers and of media opted. Private candidates shall normally opt for subsequent attempts, from the same centre from which they first appeared. The Board of Intermediate Education has also right to change or modify the centre requested for by the private candidates without assigning reasons therefore.
12. Candidates must obtain their hall tickets from the Principal of colleges through which they have forwarded their applications three days before the commencement of the examination. Hall tickets will not be sent to the candidates directly.
13. The candidates who have passed in all the papers of the 1st year Intermediate Public Examination in the one sitting and who are desirous of improving their performance in one or more papers, are permitted to do so in the immediate supplementary examination only and they have to pay the fee of Rs.100/-. In such cases the benefit of best marks will be given.
14. The failed candidates can appear in the papers in which they have been declared as failed and qualify for a pass by securing a minimum of 35% marks in them. If they desire to avail the benefit of revised regulations i.e the minimum of 30% marks in each paper with 35% in the aggregate to get a pass they have to appear in all papers once again. The fee for such re-appearance in all papers is Rs.75.00 only and their latest marks i.e. marks secured in I.P.E October, shall alone will be retained. No benefit of best marks will be allowed to them, and their previous marks will be wiped out.
15. The following documents should be enclosed to the application.
 - a) Certified copy of memo of marks of qualifying examination, if this is first appearance.
 - b) Original memo of marks of Intermediate Public Examination if appeared previously for the Intermediate Public Examination.
 - c) Exemption certificate in the case of private candidates appearing for the Intermediate Examination (First time).
16. Candidates should have their hall tickets ready with them for inspection by the Chief/Asst. Supdt. /Departmental Officer of the examination Centre or any other officer authorised for this purpose at any time during the examination. No one coming after half an hour to the examination hall will be admitted and no one should leave the examination hall within the half-an-hour after the commencement of the examination.

17. Candidate should carefully scrutinise the correctness of their names, subjects appearing and medium etc., indicated in their hall-tickets with respect to nominal roll. Any discrepancy should be brought to the notice of the Chief Superintendent immediately for rectification.
