2. Candidates appearing for improvement shall make them selves acquainted fully about the rules of improvement.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

HOW TO FILL IN APPLICATION FORM.

1. All the entries in the application form except Regd. No. Should be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.
2. The application form duly filled in should be submitted to the principal of the college where the candidate is studying not later than the prescribed date.
3. The date of payment without penal fee and with penal fee are given in the notification already issued. Candidates may contact the principals concerned in this regard. No application will be received by the principal of the college concerned after the expiry of the last date prescribed even though the fee is paid in time.
4. The entries under Nos. 2 to 5 in the application should exactly correspond with those recorded in the certificate of the qualifying examination such as SSLC, SSC, MATRICULATION etc.,
5. Applications with incomplete and incorrect entries or liable to rejected.
6. In submitting an application for registration to the public examination, the candidate will be deemed to have given an undertaking that he/she will abide by all rules now in force and that may be brought into effect hereinafter.
7. Candidates should pay the examination fee in any Branch of State of Bank of India / State Bank of Hyderabad to be credited to the current account of B.I.E., A.P within the dates prescribed.
8. No candidate will be allowed to select a centre for his/her examination other than one allotted to him in the earlier examination. However the Board reserves the right to allot a different centre without assigning any reason to any candidate.
9. Following are the rates of fee prescribed :
 - a) Fee for appearing for all the papers of the 1st year OR 2nd Year is Rs.125/-
 - b) Fee for appearing in three OR more papers of the 1st year OR 2nd year is Rs.125/-
 - c) Fee for appearing in one OR two papers of the 1st year OR 2nd year is Rs.10/-
 - d) Fee for appearing in all the 2nd year papers along Rs.250-
 - e) Fee for appearing in all the 2nd year papers along with 1 OR 2 papers of Te 1 year is Rs.230/-

- f) Fee for appearing in all papers of the 2nd year along with 3 OR more than 2 paper of the 1 year is Rs.250/-
- g) Fee for Checking the totalling of marks in each papers is Rs.100/- one month from the date of publication of results.
- h) There is no provision for re-valuation of answer books OR individual answers OR personal identification of answer scripts.
10. The Board of Intermediate Education reserves the right to cancel the admission or the performance of the candidate at any stage when it is detected that his/her admission to the college or the examination is against to regulation

HALL TICKET Etc.,

11. Candidate should collect the hall ticket 3 days earlier from the chief superintendent of centre through which they applied and keep them ready for inspection by the Chief / Asst. Superintendent / Department Officer of the Examination Centre or any other officer authorised for the purpose at any time during the examination.
12. Candidates should take their seats in the examination hall at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time. No one coming after half an hour will not be admitted and no one shall leave the examination hall within the first half an hour after the commencement of the examination.
13. Strict silence should be maintained in the examination hall.
14. The Board reserves the right to seize the hall ticket at any time before, during and after examination and the candidate should surrender the same to the authorised officer, when called for.
15. There is no provision for re-valuation of answer book or individual answers and no provision for personal identification of the answer script.
16. If there is any discrepancy in the Memo / Pass certificate, representation for rectification be made within FOUR WEEKS from the date of publication of results through the principal of college from where he/she registered along with remarks.
17. Candidates should carefully scrutinise the correctness of their names, subjects appearing, medium etc., Indicated in their Hall Tickets with respect to nominal roll. Any discrepancy noted should be brought to the notice of the Chief Superintendent immediately for rectification.
