1. In the case trainees the Head of the Training Centre should fill up and sign this form and also affix and test the photograph. It is not necessary to countersign it.
 2. The attesting officers signature should be right across the photo extending over the blank space also.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. (a) Hall tickets will be sent to the Head of the Training Institution in respect of regular candidates. In the case of private candidates, they will be sent to them directly in the self addressed envelope enclosed to the application by them.
 - (b) Hall tickets will be sent to the Head of the Training Institution in respect of all candidates from whom they should obtain them
1. Full postal address should be furnished by 'private candidates'. All communications will be sent to the address given in column 13 of the application. Requests for the change of the address will not ordinarily be attended to.
 2. Wrong and incomplete information furnished against any item of the application will run the risk of rejection of the same.
 3. In submitting an application for admission to the examination the candidate will be deemed to have given an undertaking that he will abide by all rules in force and those to be brought into effect.

For the first appearance of the examination the candidate should present all subjects of the examination.

4. Information furnished in column 3 of the application is for statistical purpose and cannot be adduced against the other admitted records.

5. IMPORTANT

It is found that several hall tickets despatched by this office do not reach their destination or are returned to this office by postal authorities. This is mainly due to the incomplete and illegible address furnished by the private candidates. As such to ensure safe and prompt delivery of the hall tickets all private candidates are required to enclose a Self-Addressed Envelop 9" X 4 ½ ".

The hall tickets-cum-identification certificate should be produced at the examination hall and shown to the Chief Superintendent whenever demanded.

The hall ticket-cum-identification certificate should be preserved by the candidates even after the examination until their results are announced and produced if demanded during this time.

Candidates should sign on the hall ticket-cum-identification certificate in the examination hall before the Chief or Assistant Superintendent, if required.

A copy of the time table is enclosed and the instructions issued therein regarding their conduct at the examination hall should be scrupulously observed.

Candidates should carefully scrutinise the nominal rolls put up in the notice board a day or two before the commencement of the examination and inform the Chief Superintendent immediately, if there is any mistake relating to name, or register number as given in the hall ticket, subjects offering, etc. If they fail to report promptly to the Chief Superintendent any omission or mistake in the nominal rolls the entire responsibility rests with the candidates.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- (1) Forms containing incomplete and incorrect particulars are liable to be rejected.
- (2) Hall-tickets will be dispatched directly to the candidates.
- (3) Each candidate should enclose a self-addressed cover of size 9”X4 ½ “ for the dispatch of the Hall-Tickets.
- (4) The fee for the examination is Rs.10 and the prescribed fee may be paid into this Treasury or Bank to the Head of Account.
- (5) The fee once paid will neither be refunded nor reserved for a subsequent examination under any circumstances.
- (6) In submitting the applications for admission to the examination the candidate will be deemed to have given an undertaking that he/she will abide by all rules now in force and those to be brought into effect hereafter.
- (7) The Centre should be one of those mentioned in Paragraph one of the notification inviting applications, and the centre selected shall be one where the candidate resides or where he is employed or if that is not a centre, the centre nearest to it.
